# HISTORY OF THE ORGAN

## First Organ

This was built in 1875 by Bishop & Sons, London. It had a mechanical action. It consisted of one manual (56 Notes) & Pedal Board (24notes). Cost £90. It was shifted to the Alberton Baptist Church in 1897 and later to Victoria.

## Second Organ

This was built in 1897 by J.E. Dodd, Adelaide and had a mechanical action. It was rebuilt in 1962 with electro-pneumatic action by J.E. Dodd & Sons, Gunstar Organ Works, Plympton.

## Rebuilt & Enlarged Organ

In 2007, Mr Leith Jacob, with the assistance of the organist, Mr Lyall von Einem, who both worked on the 1962 rebuild, began the restoration and rebuild which enlarged the organ by six new stops:

Tierce $1\frac{3}{5}$ '	(61 pipes & action)
Twelfth $2\frac{2}{3}$ '	(61 pipes & action)
Koppel Flute 4'	(61 pipes & action)
Open Diapason 16'	(12 pipes & action)
Oboe 8'	(61 pipes)
Trompette 8'	(61 pipes & action)

The control of the electro-pneumatic action was upgraded with solid-state electronics. The work was completed in 2008.
